

Double Your Salary Promotion - Terms and Conditions

1. This Program is applicable to existing Mashreq Account customers ("Customers") whose accounts are active and who are transferring salary to Mashreq.
2. All customers transferring salary to Mashreq accounts between 1st July 2020 and 30th Nov 2020 would be eligible to participate in this campaign.
3. A draw would be conducted on a monthly basis to identify 10 lucky winners every month starting July 2020 till November 2020.
4. For the identified winners, the salary transfer received during winning the month, would be credited to Mashreq account.
5. The maximum CAP of salary transfer bonus is AED 50,000 per customer across the campaign period.
6. This campaign is applicable for both new customers opening Mashreq account, and transferring salary to Mashreq during the campaign period, as well as existing customers transferring salary to Mashreq during the campaign period.

14. These Terms and Conditions are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United Arab Emirates, as applicable in the Emirate of Dubai.
15. In no event shall the Bank, any of its affiliates, or any of its officers, directors, employees or agents shall be liable or responsible for any loss, damage or expense arising out of or otherwise related to this Program.
16. The Bank shall not be in breach of its obligations or otherwise be liable to conduct this Program in the event of any Force Majeure Event. For purposes of these Terms and Conditions, in addition to the meaning of "Force Majeure Event" in the UAE law it shall also mean any and all circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Bank including, amongst other things, acts of God, industrial disputes, civil disobedience/unrest, war, acts and regulations of any governmental or authority in any jurisdiction. In such circumstances, the Bank's obligations to the customer shall automatically stand discharged without the need to provide notice to that effect.
